WEEKLY PROGRAM THEMES (2026)

Week1 (July 2nd ~3rd)

Science Experiment: All About Water!

Our upcoming science activity will focus on the fascinating world of water!

Children will have the opportunity to:

 Investigate cause and effect—What happens when water is heated? Why do some things float and others sink? (Activity: Sink & Float experiments)



 Experiment hands-on mixing, pouring, observing changes, and making predictions. (Activity: Coffee filter Art)

This experiment encourages curiosity, observation, and scientific thinking in a playful and meaningful way.

Week2 (July 7th~11th) **OH. Canada!**

This week, the children will explore the rich history and culture of Canada! Through exciting lessons and hands-on activities, they will learn about:

- Early Canadian settlers and ancestors (Activity: History of Canadian)
- Indigenous peoples and Aboriginal culture (Activity: Who is Indigenous people –
 Introduction of Indigenous people)



- Canada's provinces and territories
 (Activity: Mosaic of Canada map)
- National symbols of Canada (flag, maple leaf, beaver, etc.)
 (Activity: Canada inuksuk art)
- Calgary Stampede traditions ending with our very own Stampede Parade and Brunch!



Week3 (July 13th~17th)

All about Ocean!

Dive into the wonders of the underwater world!

This week, children will explore the fascinating ocean ecosystem, including:

- Ocean animals such as fish, whales, dolphins, sea turtles, jellyfish, and more (Activity: Beach sensory bin)
- Ocean plants and seaweeds that support marine life (Activity: Jar aquarium)
- Different ocean habitats, from coral reefs and tide pools to the deep sea (Activity: Observation ocean book, video)
- The importance of ocean conservation and caring for marine life (Activity: Making Turtle mask)
- Through creative activities, stories, crafts, and science experiments, children will experience the magic and mystery of the ocean—just like a joyful Carnival under the Sea! (Activities:

Week4 (July 20~24th)

All about space

Get ready for an exciting journey into outer space!

This week, children will explore the wonders of the universe, including:

- The **planets** in our solar system
- The **Moon** and its phases
- Spacecraft and rockets
- Astronauts and space stations
- **Stars, galaxies**, and the mysteries of space

Through fun activities, crafts, storytelling, and science experiments, children will experience what it feels like to travel through space—filled with curiosity, imagination, and discovery!

Week5 (July 27th ~ July 31st) **Our planet, Earth**

This week, children will discover the beauty and wonders of Planet Earth. They will:

- Observe fascinating Earth phenomena, such as weather, seasons, volcanoes, mountains, earthquakes, and rainbows. (Activity; Volcano experiment)
- Explore and understand the causes behind these natural events (Activity: Cloud Jar)
- Participate in hands-on science experiments to learn how our planet works (Activity: Making an earth)
- Develop appreciation for nature, landforms, water, and the environment (Activity: Landforms)
- Dinosaur world (Activity: Dinosaur experiments -Craft, sandbox with dinosaurs)

This week, children will travel around the world through Get ready for a colourful and imaginative week! **music!** They will:

- Listen to music from different countries and cultures (Activity: Introduction of African music and dance)
- Learn about traditional instruments such as drums from Africa, sitar from India, maracas from Mexico, piano and violin, and more (Guest drummer- Anders Czarnecki, African drum performance)
- Explore different rhythms, beats, and melodies (Activity: Mexican music and dance)
- Sing songs in different languages and try simple dance movements (Activity: Indian Folk song)
- Create their own musical instruments using craft materials (Activity: Rain stick making)
- Understand how music can express feelings, tell stories, and bring people together.

Week6 (Aug. 4th~7th)

World's chef

This week, children will become little **chefs of the world**! They will:

- Experience and taste foods from different countries and cultures. (Activity: making Italian pizza)
- Learn about traditional dishes, ingredients, and cooking styles from around the world (Activity: Introduction measuring cups and spoons, making a watermelon punch)
- Explore different flavors—sweet, salty, sour, spicy, and more (Activity, different flavor food experiment)
- Practice safe food handling and healthy eating habits (Activity: Healthy & Unhealthy food education)
